

Bursaries:

Warwick Academy offers bursaries from Reception to Year 13. Assistance is given based on need. We have offered on average 100 awards a year ranging from \$1,000 to \$6,000. We are here to assist, as it is vitally important that the lives of our young people and their educational opportunities are not affected by lack of financial means.

Our bursaries are supported by earnings from an endowment fund. While we continue to try and build this fund we are limited to the amount of earnings it provides. Please feel free to contact the Development Office if you would like to donate to this worthy cause.

Governors' Scholarships:

One full academic **Governors' External Bermudian Scholarship** will be awarded to an external Bermudian Year 4 student entering Warwick Academy in Year 5. The Scholarship shall be worth the full annual tuition for a particular year, available annually, for nine years, to the top scoring external Year 4 student entering Warwick Academy in Year 5. The general policy in awarding the external Governors' Scholarship shall be "to assist children in the public school system who wishes to attend Warwick Academy to be able to do so". The successful candidate for the Governors' Scholarship will be chosen based on achieving the highest score in the entrance exam as well as meeting all other requirements for acceptance to Warwick Academy. The successful candidate must also have been studying in the public school system in Bermuda for at least 3 academic years.

One full academic **Governors' Internal Scholarship** will be awarded to an internal Year 4 student entering Warwick Academy Year 5. The Scholarship shall be worth the full annual tuition for a particular year, available annually, for nine years, to the top scoring internal Year 4 student entering Year 5. The successful candidate for the Governors' Scholarship will be chosen based on the highest score achieved in the end of year exams as well as showing all the characteristics inherent to the ethos of Warwick Academy.

All students awarded a Governors' Scholarships must maintain good academic and behavioural standards in order to have their awards renewed. In particular, a student must obtain 80% effort grades of 1 or 2 and must achieve 2nd Honours except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Education Committee

One **Governors' Bursary** will be awarded to a Bermudian Year 4 student, internal or external, entering Warwick Academy Year 5. The bursary shall be worth full annual tuition for a particular year, available annually, for nine years. Families must complete the bursary application if they wish to be considered for this award. The successful candidate for the Governors' Bursary will be chosen based on the scores they achieve in the entrance exam although that will not be the sole criteria; the Bursary will be awarded from amongst the highest scoring candidates who also demonstrate the greatest financial need. All students awarded a Governors' Bursary must maintain good academic and behavioural standards in order to have their awards renewed. They must also demonstrate ongoing financial need by completing the Financial Aid application form annually.

Should no eligible applicants entering Year 5 be suitable to receive a Governors' Bursary, then the bursary funds could be applied to eligible applicants in other year groups.

Internal Sixth Form Scholarships:

Sixth Form Scholarships will be awarded to internal Year 11 students for the Sixth Form (Year 12 & 13). These Scholarship range from \$2,000 to \$8,000 available annually, for two years, to the top scoring internal Year 11 students based on mock IGCSE exam results. Two Principal's Scholarships of \$10,500 annually for two years are awarded to two Year 11 students based on mock IGCSE exam results and financial need.

All successful candidates must also show all the characteristics inherent to the ethos of Warwick Academy.

External Sixth Form Scholarships:

Sixth Form Scholarships will be awarded to external Year 11 students entering Warwick

Academy for the Sixth Form (Years 12 & 13). There will be up to five scholarships, each up to \$2,000 per year, for two years. The successful candidates will be academically strong, wellrounded individuals and must also show all the characteristics inherent to the ethos of Warwick Academy.

All students awarded a Sixth Form Scholarships must maintain good academic and behavioural standards in order to have their awards renewed.
