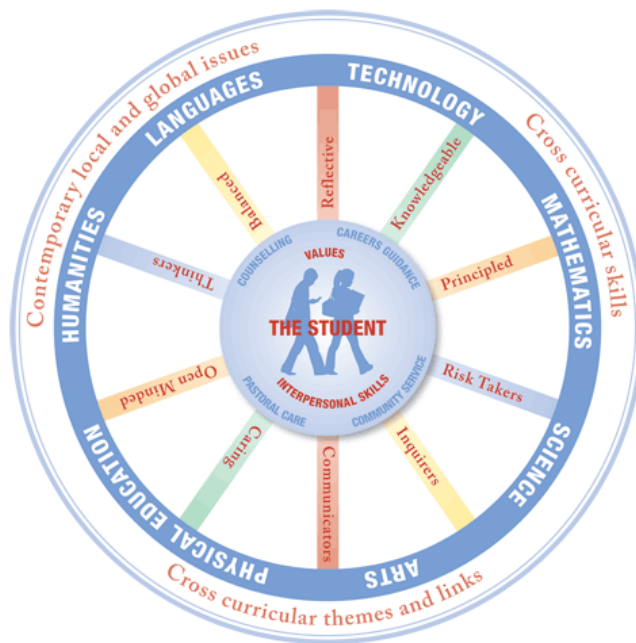

Appearance

Students should be clean, neat and well-presented when in school uniform. We believe that the requirement of an appropriate appearance is important in establishing a common standard amongst students, setting the tone for the school day, minimizing distractions amongst students thereby focusing on their learning and ensuring that they do not pose a Health & Safety risk. The Principal, Head of Primary and Head of Secondary will have the final say in any decisions related to this policy.

Hair

- Hair shall be clean, neat and clear of the face.
 - In Primary, hair must be tied back (braids/plaits, ponytail, bun etc).
 - In Secondary, hair must be tied back when not clear of the face.
- Only natural hair colour is permitted
- Students are not permitted to shave lines in their hair or eyebrows.
- Hairbands, ribbons, clips, etc., worn in the hair must be white, blue, black or brown.
- Students shall be clean-shaven
- Sixth Form students are permitted facial hair, which shall be short, neat and well groomed.
- Hairstyles that do not honour the intent of this policy are not acceptable.

Jewellery

- Primary and Y7-11 Secondary students may have one small plain stud earring worn in the lower ear lobe of one or both ears. No other jewellery may be worn with the exception of medical bracelets.
- Primary and Y7-11 Secondary students may not have any visible piercings: nose, eyebrows, tongue, etc.
- Sixth Form students may wear jewellery that is discreet and suitable for a formal business environment.
- Sixth Form students are permitted to wear one small stud nose piercing.

Make-up and nails

- Primary and Y7-11 Secondary students may not wear make-up, nail polish and false nails at any time.
- Sixth Form students may wear discreet make-up and nail polish that is suitable for a formal business environment.

Tattoos

- No visible tattoos are permitted.

Uniform

All students are expected to wear the correct uniform and **all items must be clearly labelled.**

Summer uniform dates: Start of Term 3 (April) - 30th November.

Winter uniform dates: 1st December – End of Term 2 (March). Students may opt to wear it after the October half-term break.

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PE/Activities Uniform

- WA tracksuit.
- WA navy PE shirt.
- WA navy PE shorts.
- White or black socks.
- Sneakers.
- House shirt only for House days.
- Sixth Form can wear their WA Sixth Form branded fleece and branded sweat pants for activities.
- Plain navy or black one-piece swimsuit for girls and jammers for boys.
- Swim cap for students with shoulder length hair.
- Knee-length navy socks if playing soccer, rugby or hockey for school matches.

Outer clothing and rain gear

- Plain dark rain suits or outer jackets which must be removed when students enter school.
- No hooded jackets or non-WA sweat tops to be worn.

Primary Uniform

Primary operates a “**No Hat No Play**” policy. WA regulation bucket hats, baseball caps or visors must be worn during warmer months (when in summer uniform) when eating lunch, out at play or in a PE lesson. Students who do not have a hat stay seated at the benches in the lunch quad, under the awning.

- House shirt (*all students joining the school are given their first House shirt during their first week of school – as this is included in initial fees, parents do not need to purchase one*).
- Years 5 & 6 – PE bag – drawstring.

All Primary children may wear their PE uniform to school on gym days. In cooler months students may also wear the Warwick Academy tracksuit.

Swimming Lessons

Swim cap (*purchased from school*) must be worn by all students with hair that falls below the ears.

- **Reception Year:** no school uniform expectations
- **Girls Years 1 - 3:** Navy Tankini (*purchased from school*)
- **Girls Years 4 - 6:** One-piece navy swimsuit* (*some sizes available at school*)
- **Boys Years 1 - 6:** Navy tight jammers* (*purchased from school*) – these allow the instructor to see the correct swim stroke and allow the student to have full range of motion in the early stages of the programme.

It has also been agreed that students may wear the close-fitting bodysuit type swimwear tops (navy blue, black or white) designed to protect children from harmful rays.
