



TEACHING POSITIONS

Secondary Teacher of Spanish & French (two posts)

A fluent Spanish teacher is sought to teach Spanish throughout the Secondary School to UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, I/GCSE and International Baccalaureate Higher and Standard levels; and French to UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3 and I/GCSE.

Secondary Teacher of Food & Nutrition/Technology

A Secondary Teacher is required to teach Food & Nutrition/Technology across all classes within the Secondary School, preparing students for IGCSE at the end of Year 11 and the BTEC Hospitality Course in Years 12 & 13.

Secondary Teacher of Physical Education

A Secondary Teacher of Physical Education is required to teach across the Secondary School (Year 7-13). GCSE PE and BTEC Sport academic teaching knowledge and experience is vital for the role as is the ability to coach a variety of sports during and after the school day. In keeping with our internal employment structure and mandate of equal representation within the Secondary Physical Education Department we ideally require a female for this position.

Upper Primary Teacher (with an English focus)

A Primary Teacher experienced in the UK National Curriculum, including assessment procedures, and a willingness to teach across the Primary School is required. The position involves the teaching of English to Year 6 and candidates must demonstrate strong literacy teaching skills. The successful applicant will also be expected to support and potentially lead our Drama Club and Upper Primary Drama Production, with experience in this area invaluable. In addition, they will be a Homeroom Teacher and will need experience in supporting children pastorally.

Requirements:

All applicants must be fully qualified teachers who should hold an appropriate honours degree in their main teaching subject, at least 3 years' teaching experience, a teacher training certificate at the appropriate level for the post and must be prepared to contribute to the school's extensive co-curricular programme. Secondary Teacher of Biology and General Science

A Secondary School teacher is sought to teach Biology to the IB Higher/Standard levels and the I/GCSE years; and General Science to students in Key Stage 3 following the UK National Curriculum.

Secondary Teacher of Physics and General Science

A Secondary School teacher is sought to teach Physics to the IB Higher/Standard levels and the I/GCSE years; and General Science to students in Key Stage 3 following the UK National Curriculum. In addition, the ability to teach Computer Science and/or deliver a Robotics programme will be favourably looked at.

Secondary Teacher of Design Technology

A Secondary School teacher is sought to lead Design Technology throughout the 11-18 age range including the UK National Curriculum Key Stage 3, the I/GCSE, and IB Higher/Standard Levels.

Secondary Teacher of Geography, Global Citizenship, and Head of Sixth Form

This position involves the pastoral leadership of the Sixth Form and senior management experience in this type of role is a requirement.
