Applicants must be able to show at least 3 years' experience across the UK National Curriculum and IGCSE (or an equivalent) and be able to relate positively to students, staff and parents. It is expected that the successful candidate will have well developed interpersonal skills and the ability to work effectively with a highly motivated team of teachers.
